- \* You are welcome to accompany applicants to an Admissions meeting. Admissions meetings are scheduled as needed and to accommodate everyone's schedules.
- \* Help your applicant to fulfill the 2 function obligation. Invite them to meetings, bring them to a work party, or join a cruise. Keep them informed and make sure they feel welcome. We suggest that you give them a copy of the Jib sheet.
- \* You will be contacted to accompany applicant to the induction meeting.
- \* During the months of June, July and August the new membership process is not available because most of the membership is on vacation.

Thank you for your interest in the Quatermaster Yacht Club. We would like to tell you a little about the club.

QYC was organized for the purpose of encouraging boating and yachting of all kinds, and to take advantage of the natural recreational opportunities in our area. Our membership is representative of a cross section of the community.

The facilities of the club include floats for moorage and a clubhouse located on the shore of inner Quatermaster Harbor. Our moorage facilities are limited and currently there is a waiting list for slips. The club is supported by moorage fees and annual dues. Maintenance and building projects are performed and supported by the membership. Work parties are arranged as needed and all members are required to participate within their abilities.

The social events include dinner dances, summer potlucks, cruises, sailboat races, predicted log races and a traditional Opening Day celebration. In addition, there are general membership meetings on the 3rd Thursday of the month, 7:30 p.m. in our clubhouse - Meyers Hut. Some of these meetings are held in conjunction with potluck dinners and most have a planned program with a subject of boaters' general interest. There is also a Youth Sailing Program that includes non-member Island youth.

The initiation fee for new members is \$1,000.00 and annual dues are \$300. To be considered for membership, you must reside on Vashon/Maury Islands. Prospective members must be sponsored by two Life or Active members. Applicants shall attend two general club functions, as guests, before submitting their applications.

We look forward to meeting you and hope that this letter has provided you with some pertinent information of Quatermaster Yacht Club. The Secretary will notify you when the Board has considered your application.
